Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 29 August 2017 were agreed.

Programme Progress Report

It was noted that good progress had been made across all programme areas and that the consultation programme was proceeding as planned.

Planning Application

Mr Kenworthy from Barton Willmore briefed the Steering Group on the consultation workshop sessions that were being held with local residents and businesses at the Roehampton Parish Hall. An article would be placed in the next edition of the regeneration newsletter to inform residents on how they can continue to participate in consultation and contribute their ideas. It was noted that the planning application was on track for submission to the Local Planning Authority in early 2018.

Bessborough Road Satellite Site

Mr Cox updated the Steering Group on the progress of this satellite site residential development. It is intended that the planning application will be submitted to the Local Planning Authority by the end of 2017.

Community and Stakeholder Engagement

Mr Cox briefed the Steering Group on recent discussions between Hawkins/Brown Architects and the management of the Eastwood Nursery Children's Centre and School over the design principles and potential wider community uses for their new premises at Portswood Place. The Steering Group noted that a flyer had been prepared to be distributed to circa 5,000 local residents informing them of the consultation 'open house' exhibition being held in the Roehampton Parish Hall on 29 and 30 September 2017.
